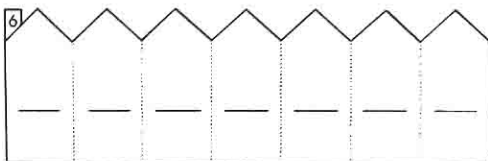

Class Time
