

Him.” The Lord has a special love for those who obey Him, or *do* what He says. The Lord loves the people who disobey Him, too, but He does not love the bad things they do. He wants them to stop doing bad things so that He will not have to punish them.

\*Have the children copy the sentence “The Lord loves all that obey Him” twice on the lines directly below the sentence.

**Be sure that the children make their lines straight in forming both the small and capital letter *L*. Watch their spacing immediately following capital *L*.** The next letter may tend to get too close to it because of the shape of the letter *L*.

**Remind the children of their posture** as they do the lesson. They should be sitting against the back of their seats, leaning slightly forward from the hips, with both feet on the floor and both arms on the desk.
