A. Vocabulary

1. Let the children say the sound word.
2. Before you print the word *angry*, ask the children if they can guess your word. "It is an unhappy feeling that someone might have if you hurt him or broke something that was his." Print the word and a sentence for it. *Do not be angry if he is bad to you.* Let it remain on the board for the children's reference if they forget the word.
3. Let the children sound *done* according to the rules and tell them that here we have another word that does not follow the rule. Print *done = dun* on the board and help the children to understand it.
4. The word *liked* can also be very nearly sounded by the phonics that the children know. Printing *He liked the pie.* may help.
5. Ask which new or review word(s)—
 - a. means "finished." (done)
 - b. means "like God." (godly)
 - c. names groups of people. (families)
 - d. means "allow." (let)
 - e. is a word you might say when pointing to something. (that)
 - f. is a question word. (why)
 - g. is a wrong kind of feeling. (angry)
 - h. make you think of nighttime. (moon, rest)
 - i. have two syllables. (angry, other, people, godly)
 - j. have three syllables. (animal, families)
6. Drill the word and phrase cards.
7. Use the *Extra Practice* lists in the reader.

B. Reader

Have the children study silently and read orally.
Review Romans 12:9b.

C. Bible lesson

"Have you ever seen someone who was very angry? How does such a person act? Do you like to be around people when they are angry?"

"We do not like when people are angry. God does not like it, either."

"Who was angry in our story? Why was Cain angry? Why did God not like what Cain did?"

"What should Cain have done when God did not like what he did? Did Cain do right? What did he do instead? Did he have a good reason to become angry?"

"Can you think of any reason it would be all right to become angry? Suppose someone kicks you on purpose. That is bad. Should you be bad then, too, just because someone else is bad? No. You should still be good. And you should not become angry. Then maybe the other person would be nice to you."
