5. Define *reckon* and *gainsaying*. Gainsaying: opposing; contrary; contradictory.

7. What three parts of man, which make up his whole being, are cleansed and kept by God's sanctifying and preserving work? [1 Thessalonians 5:23] spirit, soul, and body
8. What expressions in 1 Corinthians 6:11 describe God's instantaneous sanctification? "Ye are washed," "Ye are sanctified," "Ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus."
9. What phrase did Paul use in 2 Corinthians 7:1 that expresses continual sanctification? "perfecting holiness in the fear of God"
10. Define *sanctify* and *wholly*. Sanctify: set apart; purify; consecrate. Wholly: completely; entirely; perfectly.
