

## HOW TO HANDLE SHARP ARTICLES

Lesson 25

**Lesson Aim:** To teach the safe way to handle scissors, knives, and chairs.

**Procedure:** Lesson 26 deals with running with sharp articles. Help the pupils see that many accidents can be avoided when handling these items if caution is practiced.

- Answers:**
1. wrong—Child should be cutting with knife blade going away from him.
  2. right
  3. right
  4. wrong—Child should hand the handle of the scissors to the other person.
  5. right
  6. wrong—She should carry the chair by its back in front of her.

## WALKING INDOORS

Lesson 26

**Lesson Aim:** To teach self-control indoors.

**Procedure:** Walking is much safer than running inside unless permission is given to run in a large area. Sometimes this is necessary such as on a rainy day. Teach children to walk in public buildings such as churches, schools, and hospitals.

**Answers:** Individual work. The children have disobeyed the rule to never run in halls or on stairways.

**Note:** For Lesson 27 try to find a medicine bottle with a skull and crossbones sign on it to show the class.

## MEDICINE CABINETS

Lesson 27

**Lesson Aim:** To teach caution concerning medicines.

**Procedure:** Children should be warned never to take any medicine—whether liquid or capsule—unless directed by a doctor or their parents. Familiarize students with the poison sign.

- Answers:**
1. Get an older person to help you if you are sick.
  2. Poison.
  3. You should take the medicine given to *you*.
  4. A cut must be clean to heal properly.
  5. No, God does the healing.
