

Lesson 29

Introducing Part A

Pronounce the spelling words clearly for students while they look at the word list and say each word after you. Stress pronouncing the /t/ sound distinctly. Point out, however, that *burned* does not end with /t/ as *burnt* does. These are forms of the same word, but their endings are different.

Give clues on the word meanings as follows, and have students say and spell the words.

A rabbit's — is soft. (*fur*)

The barn — in the fire last night. (*burned*)

It is a kind of tree. (*fir*)

It is something a boy wears. (*shirt*)

God put a — in the sky after the Flood. (*rainbow*)

It may mean the same as *soil* or *world*. (*earth*)

Are you — any new words today? (*learning*)

Sometimes we must — to get finished on time.

(*hurry*)

Assign Part A.

Introducing Part B

Call attention to the title picture. The words shown are

a *fir* tree and an animal with *fur*.

Discuss the different ways to spell the /ɛr/ sound. In which spelling words is /ɛr/:

Spelled *ir*? (*dirt, dirty, thirty, shirt, fir*)

Spelled *ur*? (*fur, hurt, burned, hurry*)

Spelled *ear*? (*early, earth, learning*)

Spelled *or*? (*world*)

Assign Part B.

Introducing Part C

Have students tell whether the first word in each pair comes *before* or *after* the second word in alphabetical order.

first—flash *egg—easy* *curl—crack*

Assign Part C.

Additional Activity

Dictate sentences as follows.

1. Did you get your shirt dirty?

2. Many fir trees burned in the fire.

3. Hurry so that you get there early.

Check the papers for end punctuation and capitalization.

The word list has been compacted to fit onto two pages in this booklet.
