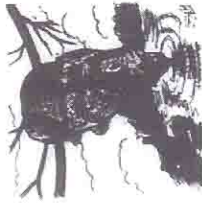


Lesson 21 Capitals With Reverse Loops

Have you ever seen a cat 8 feet (2.5 meters) long? Yes, some cats are that big, but they are not house cats. One kind of big, wild cat that lives in the United States and Canada is called the cougar. The cougar has a frightening scream; but usually it is not dangerous and avoids people if it can.



We have already reviewed the capitals that start with loops made in the regular way. Today we will practice the two with reverse loops. They have the same size and slant that regular loops have, but the curve goes in the opposite direction.
