

C. Building Words

Syllables

If a word has one consonant between two vowels, it is divided after the consonant if the first vowel is short: VC/V. **met/al**
 If the first vowel is long, the word is divided after the first vowel: V/CV. **me/ter**

1. Write **copy** and **robin**. Use slashes to divide the syllables.

2. Write **sofa** and **wafers**. Use slashes to divide the syllables.

• A syllable containing a short vowel sound usually ends with a consonant. A syllable containing a long vowel sound usually ends with that long vowel sound.

3. Write **dollar** and **study**. Use slashes to divide the syllables.

4. Write **tiger** and **Bible**. Use slashes to divide the syllables.

5. To make most nouns plural, we add **s** to the noun. Write four NEW WORDS that are plural nouns.

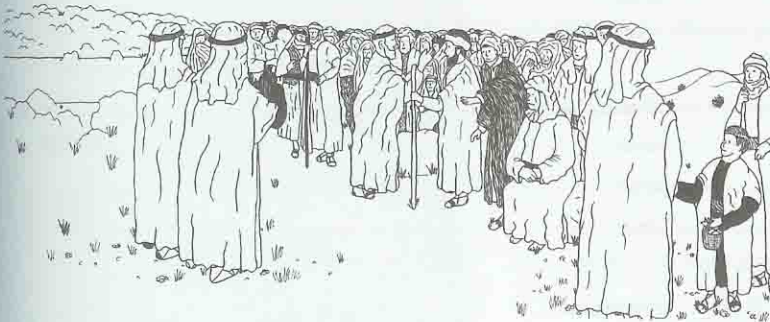
