2. *Try to find out from an encyclopedia, commentary, or Bible dictionary some details about Paul's life after what is recorded in the last chapter of Acts.*

It appears that Paul was set free and traveled to Asia Minor again. He also visited Crete (as indicated by the epistle to Titus) and perhaps even Spain. Later he was arrested again. It was during his last imprisonment that he wrote 2 Timothy.
