Scientists have observed many things with telescopes and microscopes that Job never imagined. But God had perfect knowledge about these things all along. Give some facts that have been discovered about the following items.

a. snow

Snow consists of six-sided crystals, and every one is different.

b. hail

Hail forms during thunderstorms when small ice crystals contact supercooled water droplets. Some of the water freezes, forming a layer of ice over the crystal. Updrafts carry the hailstone repeatedly into the region of supercooled water, where additional layers of ice are added. Finally the hailstone falls to the earth.

c. stars

Stars are so far from the earth that the distance is measured in light-years. Only a tiny fraction of all the stars is visible without a telescope.

d. breadth of the earth

The earth measures about eight thousand miles in diameter and twenty-five thousand miles in circumference.
