

Notes on Part B

Exercise 5: The last four words have the intermediate syllable *ca* between the root word and suffix. Students will probably have little trouble because the forms are familiar.

Exercise 8: Review the rule for changing *y* to *i* when adding a suffix to a word that ends with *y*. When *y* follows a consonant, change it to *i* to add *es*.
